## teams

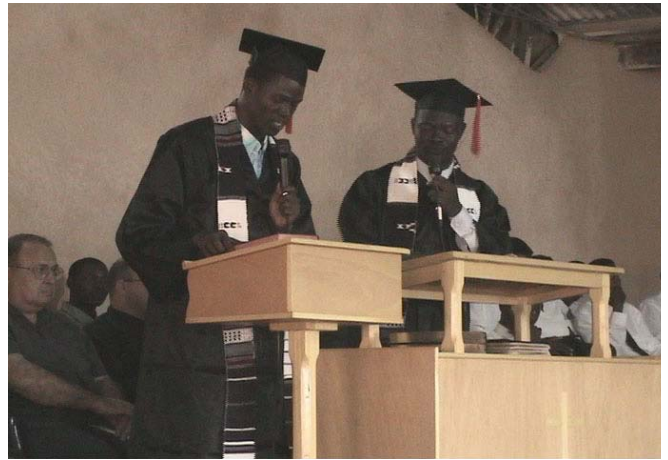


In September we hosted a construction team from North Texas led by Ron Barnard, pastor of Heritage Assembly of God in Wichita Falls. They completed the construction of a new church in central Niger in the strategic city of Birni N'Konni. Each night we held evangelistic services and many Muslims accepted Christ as their Savior.



In August we were privileged to host Niger Assemblies of God's first medical team. Part of the team treated people in several local churches, while another part of the team operated at the Niamey National Hospital. Brent served as their interpreter in the operating room and liaison with the hospital staff. We have new open doors at the hospital. The director has invited us to remodel a room to serve as a Christian chapel.

On June 26th we celebrated our 6th Bible School graduation and ordained 4 ministers. The Assemblies of God of Niger now has 6 ordained, 5 licensed, and 6 certified ministers. With 32 existing churches we still do not have enough pastors to meet the need.

We thank God for the media studio and for the open doors that He has given us for media ministry. We are producing radio programs to broadcast nationwide. Several radio stations are giving us free airtime. Dewayne Holden, missionary associate to Niger, will be training Nigeriens in media production. Media is a key to reaching many Muslims and nomads who would not normally pass through the doors of the church.

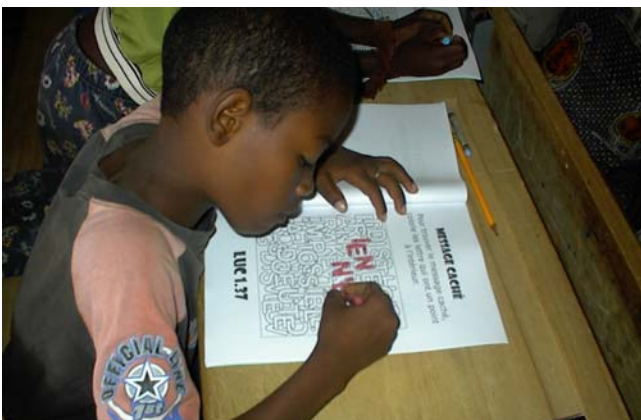
## camps
