We have been focusing on ministering in villages in the Western District. Many villages are opening to the Gospel and are requesting that someone come and start a church. What a privilege it is to partner with our former Bible school students to plant new churches. We held the first baptism in the village of Koulougou. Shelley taught the children and Brent preached to the new Christians.





Tabernacle Kits Made in Niger

With the help of Charity Harris, his team from Oklahoma and Tuxedo Assembly of God in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, we erected tabernacle kits in the villages of Alembaré, Boubon, Tchilatchanga, and Karey Gorou. Over a hundred believers are attending the new church at Boubon (pictured left). This is the new model of tabernacle kit that we are having fabricated in Niamey. The new kits are 27x36 ft. and cost about \$5,000. The villagers will make mud blocks and construct the walls once the rains come.

Move of God in villages

There is a move of God happening among the Gourmantché people group. In the area around Say where we have been ministering 8 churches have been planted in the past 6 months. The French missionaries have planted 16 churches in the Torodi region. We have planted 3 churches near Gueladio. Hundreds of villagers are coming to Christ. We believe that this is the beginning of a move of God that could sweep across Niger.
